ATD Professional Development Programs

- AHCCCS is using funding made available by the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 to increase access to home and communitybased services (HCBS) and assist with workforce retention.
- As a result, AHCCCS has partnered with ATD to provide expert-led professional development programs at no cost to eligible Arizona Medicaid providers who deliver HCBS to enrolled AHCCCS members.
- The two ATD Professional Development Programs being offered for HCBS Providers serving AHCCCS members are the Integrated Talent Management Certificate Program and the Training and Facilitation Certificate Program.





The purpose of the AHCCCS and ATD partnership is to:

- Increase the effectiveness of provider trainers through ATD's globally recognized <u>train-the-trainer</u> certificate program.
- Help HR and Workforce Development Professionals create and support workforce development strategies using an <u>integrated talent management</u> approach to achieve measurable results for their organization.
- Support leadership through <u>Executive Session Series</u> to create awareness of workplace and workforce trends led by leading talent development experts.

What does attendance look like?

When does this opportunity begin?

- The Integrated Talent Management program will be offered:
 - Starting in Arizona in January 2024!
 - Continuing through Spring 2024.
 - The registration link previously provided identifies the specific dates and times.

Where do you go to attend?

- The Integrated Talent Management program is:
 - Delivered entirely online through Adobe Connect, from the convenience of your Arizona home office or corporate office.
 - Facilitated by a skilled, professional facilitator certified by ATD who once was also new to the field and also attended their first program in training and facilitation.
 - Please take effort to ensure the physical environment in which you attend is supportive of your full attention, ability to consistently be present (*Be Here Now*) and eliminates or reduces distractions.

 - Remind your team, colleagues, direct supervisor and leadership in advance


