Traditional Healing: In partnership with leaders of Tribal nations, AHCCCS has received approval to cover traditional healing services provided through Indian Health Service (IHS) and Tribally-operated health facilities (pending legislative approval). Learn about the program’s overview, eligibility, covered services, and the next steps of implementation.

Automated Member Surveys: As required by Laws 2024, Chapter 200, ([SB 1609](#)) AHCCCS is studying how we could implement real-time, automated surveys to members with a serious mental illness or their representatives. The feasibility study will help determine potential cost to develop and distribute real-time surveys, identify quality-of-care concerns, and respond to member needs. AHCCCS is seeking input from the community on how members would like to receive and interact with surveys.
