What is a Release of Information (ROI)?

Would you like others to be involved in your health care?

AHCCCS members have a right to privacy and who they want to involve in their care. Having a Release of Information (ROI) removes barriers that can often stand in the way of your providers' ability to speak with your chosen supporters.

An ROI allows you to identify the persons/ entities you'd like included in supporting



your health care decisions when receiving services. You are still in control of your health care decisions no matter with whom you share your information. You can decide whether a provider should share all of your medical information or only the medical information you choose. Note that sharing information related to substance use treatment will require you to provide a description for why the information is being released.

You are able to create or modify an ROI with your provider at any time, if you decide to change who is involved with your care.

There is no standard ROI form and it may change from one provider to another. To see the ROI for AHCCCS, click here.
