

Improvements to Provider Revalidation Online File

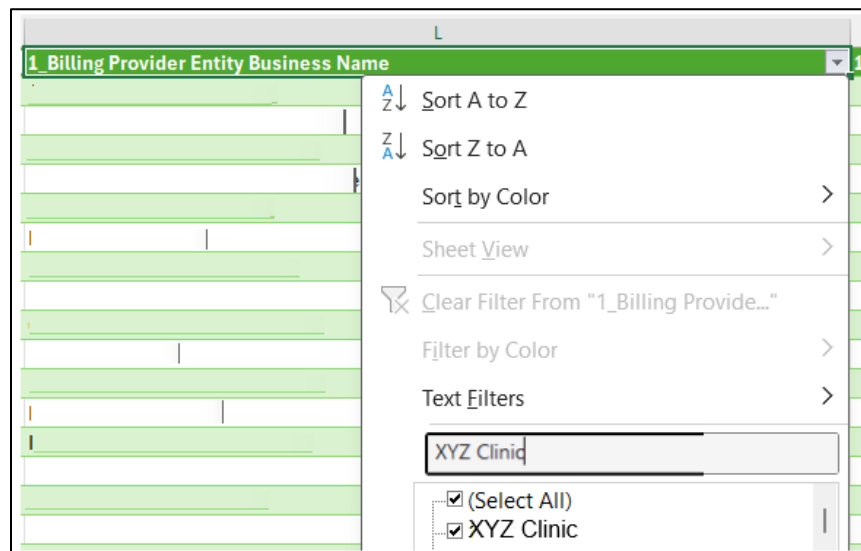
AHCCCS is committed to improving service to providers by keeping you informed of upcoming changes. In July 2025, the Provider Revalidation file that is posted publicly on the AHCCCS website is being improved to show billers that are associated with providers who are required to revalidate.

Who Is Impacted?

- All providers

What Is Changing?

In July 2025, the revalidation web post will be enhanced so that associated billers can filter by the name of their billing entity to identify who in their group needs to revalidate. To use the filter, enter your organization's name in the search field of the filter dropdown.



If your organization has providers who need to revalidate, your group name will be found here. Once you apply the filter, providers who are associated with your organization will show up with relevant details about their upcoming revalidation.

Action Required

Immediate action is not required. Organizations should use the revalidations web listing as a tool to identify their associated providers who are required to revalidate. When a provider associated with your organization is required to revalidate, it's important to work with the provider to get the revalidation application submitted in the AHCCCS Provider Enrollment Portal (APEP) prior to the due date to avoid the provider being terminated.
