From March 1, 2024, to April 1, 2024, the population increased by 10,971 members, or less than 1%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from March 1, 2024, to April 1, 2024, were:

- 6,161 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 986 QI - 1

The major decrease in the AHCCCS population from March 1, 2024, to April 1, 2024, were:

- 4,993 AHCCCS for Families & Children
- 4,204 SOBRA Child
- 8,390 Prop 204 Restoration
- 1,574 Adult Expansion
